**Registration Schedule for Centralized Admission Process (CAP) for
BSc Nursing Courses for the Academic Year 2026-27**

The State Common Entrance Test Cell, Maharashtra, being the Competent Authority for admissions to BSc Nursing Courses under MUHS, Nashik, invites online applications from eligible candidates who have qualified in **MH-NURSING CET 2026** and seek admission to **BSc Nursing courses** under the Centralized Admission Process (CAP) for the Academic Year **2026-27**.

Admissions to Government, Government Aided, Municipal Corporation, Private Unaided and such other Nursing Colleges as notified by the Government shall be carried out strictly on the basis of the merit obtained in **MH-NURSING CET 2026**

The detailed Information Brochure containing eligibility criteria and counselling process and important instructions is available on the official admission portal. Candidates are advised to read the Information Brochure carefully before submitting the online application form. Mere registration shall not confer any right to admission, which shall be subject to fulfillment of all eligibility conditions and verification of documents.

All eligible candidates are requested to visit the official admission portal regularly for updates, notifications, schedules and further instructions regarding the admission process. Separate registration with the State Competent Authority for CAP process is mandatory even if candidate has appeared for MH-NURSING CET 2026.

- The schedule for subsequent rounds for BSc Nursing courses will be declared in due course. Candidates should follow the official website regularly for updates.

Important Instruction

- Only candidates who have qualified MH-NURSING CET 2026 are eligible to register for the Centralized Admission Process in this phase.
- Registration shall be completed only through the online admission portal within the prescribed period.
- Candidates shall upload all requisite documents in the prescribed format and ensure that the information furnished in the application form is correct and complete.

- It will be the sole responsibility of the candidate to upload all the necessary documents within the given period, failure to upload the requisite documents within the given schedule may lead to non-granting of the claim or cancellation of the form.
- Candidates should also ascertain her/his eligibility for admission to the various courses before filling up the registration form.
- PWD candidates should have claimed the quota at the time of MH-NURSING CET 2026. They will have to undergo physical examination with the Medical Board to be eligible. The details of the board will be shared in due course.
- As per G.R. of General Administration Department ROD-4019/C.R 31/ 16- A, dated 12 February 2019 and Government Resolution no. MED-1018/C.R 37/19/Edu- 2, dated 07th March, 2019. "EWS" means Economically Weaker Section include persons who are not covered under the scheme of reservation for SC, ST, DT-A, NT-B, NT-C, NT-D, OBC (Including SBC) & SEBC.
- Candidates claiming EWS should submit EWS certificate valid for Academic Year 2026-27 and issued in Maharashtra State Government format only. The required format is given in the information brochure. **Central Government Format will not be considered as valid.**
- Candidates belonging to reservation category must claim so in the application form before submitting the same.
- Candidates claiming reservation should ensure that they have all the necessary documents ready at the time of registration i.e Caste Certificate, Caste Validity certificate and Non Creamy Layer Certificate (Wherever applicable)
- As per the Government Resolution issued by the General Administration Department, Government of Maharashtra, dated 02nd July 2026, the time limit for submitting the Caste Validity Certificate for OBC and SEBC candidates only has been extended up to six months from the date of registration for the Centralized Admission Process (CAP). However, candidates should note that if they fail to submit the document within the given period their admission shall be cancelled and they will be liable for any penalty for lapse of seat as per the Information Brochure.
- Candidates need to pay the applicable fees at the college for physical joining. The fees shall be paid through DD. Payment of Fees through Cheque is allowed only on Bank Holidays. However, the cheque shall be replaced by DD on next working day. If the candidate fails to replace the Cheque with DD on next working day, the admission is liable to be cancelled and the candidate will himself be responsible for such a cancellation.

Candidates are advised to regularly visit the official website i.e. www.mahacet.org for notifications, updates and further instructions regarding the admission process.
